ENTRY FEE: \$25 per team member (*maximum of 12 players in 7 v 7 divisions and maximum of 18 players in 10 v 10 divisions*) if entered by May 31. \$10 late fee per team if received between June 1 and June 25. On-site entries accepted. Entry fee includes athlete T-shirt, passes to SportFest and the Opening Ceremonies and a copy of the Nebraska Sports Council Yearbook.

COMPETITION FORMAT: Clubs will be guaranteed two games. Divisions may be completed in one day depending on number of entries. Games will consist of two 7-minute halves for the 7v7 with a 2-minute halftime and two 10-minute halves for the 10v10 with a 2-minute halftime. Liberal substitutions permitted to extent of roster.

SCHEDULES: Schedules will be posted at CornhuskerStateGames.com approximately one week prior to the start of play.

TEAM ROSTER: The TEAM ROSTER/WAIVER form must be fully completed and signed by each team member, including the team manager, coach or captain (*or by parent/guardian, if a minor*).

ROSTER CHANGE: Substitutions and additions (*up to the maximum roster size*) to originally-submitted team rosters will be allowed through June 22 with a \$10 roster-change fee for each player change. For roster additions the \$25 player fee will be added to the roster-change fee. A Roster Change Form, available only at CornhuskerStateGames.com, must be completed by the team representative and submitted to the Games office along with all roster-change fees by 5 p.m. on June 22.

AWARDS: Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to all members of the top three clubs.
