## **AGE GROUP DEFINITIONS:**

**Men Open:** Any male player.

**Coed:** These teams must have at least three males and three females of any age.

**High School:** Any full-time student in the 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade at the end of the 2009-2010 school year. Students may need to provide proof of school status via a school I.D. card.

**Junior High:** Any full-time student in the 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> grade at the end of the 2009-2010 school year. Students may need to provide proof of school status via a school I.D. card.

**Elementary:** Any full-time student in the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> grade at the end of the 2009-2010 school year. Students may need to provide proof of school status via a school I.D. card.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$22 per person (*maximum of 10 players*) if entered by May 31. \$10 per team late fee if received between June 1 and June 7. Entry fee includes athlete T-shirt, passes to SportFest and the Opening Ceremonies and a copy of the Nebraska Sports Council Yearbook.

**COMPETITION FORMAT:** Teams will play a round robin tournament for seeding then a single or double elimination tournament depending on the number of teams in each division. All teams guaranteed four games. The director reserves the right to reclassify teams as needed and may combine events depending on the number of entries.

**TEAM ROSTER:** The TEAM ROSTER/WAIVER form must be fully completed and signed by each team member, including the team manager, coach or captain (*or by parent/guardian, if a minor*).

**RULES:** Six to ten players per team, six players will start each game. Players are “out” of the game when hit below the shoulders or when a thrown ball is caught. Each game to be played on an indoor volleyball court. Six balls in play at same time during competition. There will be a 5-minute time limit for each game. First team to eliminate all members of the opposing team within regulation wins the game. Official Cornhusker State Games rules enforced by court officials using the “honor system” and player code of conduct. Court official rulings are final, no exceptions.

**ROSTER CHANGE:** Substitutions and additions (*up to the maximum roster size*) to originally-submitted team rosters will be allowed through June 22 with a \$10 roster-change fee for each player change. For roster additions the \$22 player fee will be added to the roster-change fee. A Roster Change Form, available only at [CornhuskerStateGames.com](http://CornhuskerStateGames.com), must be completed by the team representative and submitted to the Games office along with all roster-change fees by 5 p.m. on June 22.

**AWARDS:** Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to all members of the top three teams in each division.
