**NOTE:** Age determined as of June 26, 2010. Race is an American Bicycle Association (ABA) sanctioned single point race. All participants must be a current member of the ABA. If a participant wishes to participate and is not a current ABA member, a 1-day membership pass will be offered at no additional cost. Participants must register and compete at their current ABA classification. There will be no riding out of class.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$23 per person for first event, \$9 per person for each additional event if entered by May 31. \$5 late fee if received between June 1 and June 23. Entry fee includes athlete T-shirt, passes to SportFest and the Opening Ceremonies and a copy of the NSC Yearbook.

**COMPETITION FORMAT:** If there is a full gate of riders (8), there will be three qualifying rounds and a final. Director reserves the right to combine events depending on entries.

**APPAREL AND EQUIPMENT:** All riders must have a number plate on their bike. If not, a paper plate will work. Riders must use their current assigned number from the ABA. Riders using 1-day pass will be assigned a number with registration. Riders must wear helmets with a permanent strap attached; snaps are not allowed. Helmets must have sufficient padding. ABA highly recommends a full-face helmet or one that covers the ears. Riders must also wear enclosed shoes and long pants (*waist to ankle*). No shorts, with or without shin and/or kneepads, will be allowed. Riders must wear long-sleeved or short-sleeved shirts with sufficient elbow padding. Handlebars may not exceed 30 inches in width. Handlebar grips are required and must cover any metal on the ends. Kickstands, chain guards, fenders and reflector brackets must be removed. Padding of 1/4" thickness is required on the frame's top tube, stem and handlebar crossbar and must be securely fastened. The bicycle frame and its parts must be in good condition with no broken welds or jagged exposures. Axle ends may not exceed 1/4" beyond the axle nut or must be cut. No wing nuts are allowed to secure the wheels to the frame or fork. No bicycle with any freestyle type pegs will be allowed on the track. Seats must be fastened so as not to slip during competition. Seat may not have any exposed metal or sharp edges. Bikes must have some form of operating braking system-hand and/or coaster (foot) brake. All equipment must be safe and in good condition in order to compete or practice.

**AWARDS:** Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each class. Medals will only be awarded to Nebraska riders finishing in the top 3 of each class. If an out of state rider finishes in the top 3, a trophy will be awarded by Star City BMX.

**RULES:** American Bicycle Association (ABA) competition rules will apply.

**STATE GAMES OF AMERICA:** BMX Racing medal winners will automatically qualify for the 2011 State Games of America in San Diego, CA. For more information about the State Games of America and how to qualify, visit [StateGames2011.com](http://StateGames2011.com) or call (619) 223-2033.
