

# Shooting - Sporting Clays

**DATE AND TIME:** Saturday, July 3. Competition begins at 8:30 a.m. Competitors may shoot any time between 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m.

**SITE:** Lincoln Trap & Skeet Club

## Event Name

Sporting Clays (100 targets)

Open Men (*Classes A, B and C*)

Youth (*17 & Under*)

Senior (*55 & Over*)

**NOTE:** Age determined as of July 3, 2010.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$50 per shooter if entered by May 31. Shooters may enter only one individual competition plus the team competition. \$5 late fee if received between June 1 and June 7. Entry fee includes athlete T-shirt, passes to SportFest and the Opening Ceremonies and a copy of the Nebraska Sports Council Yearbook.

**TEAM ENTRY:** Sign up on-site for \$7 per shooter (*three shooters per team*). All teams must be declared prior to shooting in individual competition. You must be pre-registered in an individual event to participate in the team event. Teams will be scored by the top two per station during individual competition. The team competition will be split into Open Teams and Youth Teams.

**COMPETITION FORMAT:** Shooters will shoot from various stations, 100 targets total. Any 12 gauge or smaller shotgun with 7 1/2 or smaller shot shell size is allowed.

**AWARDS:** Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each division, including each of the three classes in the Open division. The Lewis Class System will be used to determine medalists by class in the Open division. All ties will be drawn.

**RULES:** National Sporting Clays Association (NSCA) rules will apply.

**REGISTER AND WIN BIG!** As if the greatest sports participation experience in Nebraska weren't enough, all registered athletes in the Cornhusker State Games will be entered in the CSG Grand Prize Drawing.
