NOTE: Unlimited shooters can have any gun, any weight, and any sights. Gun must have a safe trigger.

ENTRY FEE: \$27 for first event, \$16 for each additional event if entered by May 31. \$5 late fee if received between June 1 and June 7. Entry fee includes athlete T-shirt, passes to SportFest and the Opening Ceremonies and a copy of the Nebraska Sports Council Yearbook.

COMPETITION FORMAT: Shooters may enter any number of the six weight divisions. An entry fee is required for each division entered. Each division will consist of firing 20 rounds (*five each at four separate bullseye-type targets*). The official target will be the I.B.S. 200 yd. Hunter Rifle target. Targets will be shot for score, not group size. Shooters will be allocated 30 minutes for any sight-in rounds and the 20 scoring rounds. Out-of-the-box shooters must use factory production rifles having the original stock, trigger and barrel. If re-barrelled due to age, it must be the same caliber, contour and length. Burden of proof on the shooter. Out-of-the-box division scope limits of 12x for lightweight, 24x for middleweight and unlimited for heavyweight. Variable scopes may be taped. If you have rifle-eligibility questions, contact the director.

RULES: I/R 50/50 benchrest rules will be followed. Shooters must hang and retrieve their own targets and are required to bring their own shooting stool.

NOTE FOR FOREIGN SERVICE RIFLE ONLY: SKS, AK Derivatives or other Semi Automatic or Bolt Foreign Service Rifles, 30 cal or less.

ENTRY FEE: \$27 for first event, \$16 for each additional event if entered by May 31. \$5 late fee if received between June 1 and June 7. Entry fee includes athlete T-shirt, passes to SportFest and the Opening Ceremonies and a copy of the Nebraska Sports Council Yearbook.

COMPETITION FORMAT: Shooters may enter any number events. Entries in event #2 (*John Garand Match*), may also count their score toward event #1 (*Service Rifle*), if event #1 is also entered. Each event will consist of 55 rounds, which include sighting shots, 10 shots Slow Fire Standing, 10 shots Rapid Fire Sitting from standing position, 10 shots Rapid Fire Prone from standing position and 20 shots Slow Fire Prone. All firing will be at 200 yards on NRA reduced High Power Course targets.

RULES: NRA High Powered reduced course and NRA High Powered Sporting Rifle rules will apply. High Power Service Rifles are M-1 Garand in 30.06 caliber, M-14 in .308 caliber and AR 15/AR16 in 23 caliber. Service Rifles must meet NRA rules for Service Rifle configuration, iron sights, weight and weight of the trigger pull. John Garand Rifles must meet NRA rules "as issued" (*i.e. iron sights, weight and weight of trigger pull*). Standard Service Issue 30.06 Caliber ammunition will be available to purchase at the range. High Power Match Rifles are any rifle, not over 30 caliber, any sight. High Power Sporting Rifles are any rifle, not over 30 caliber, any sight, not weighing over 9.5 lbs. Competitors in Sporting High Power Match may use only coats, gloves, etc. as appropriate for hunting as specified in NRA High Power Sporting Rifle rules. No competition coats, pants and gloves are allowed.

EQUIPMENT: Shooters must bring their own shooting mats and other appropriate equipment.

SPECIAL NOTICE: Weeping Water Gun Club is a Civilian Marksmanship Program Authorized Club. Shooters in Service Rifle, John Garand and Foreign Service Rifle events will be eligible to purchase a M1 Garand rifle from the Civilian Marksmanship Program. All C.M.P. paperwork will be available at the match for M1 Garand purchases.
