GENERAL INFORMATION

DATE: Saturday, July 18, 2020

SITE: Branched Oak State Recreation Area (15 miles northwest of Lincoln)

Registration and boat launching will be from the Lincoln Sailing Club site. **NO**

ACTIVITIES WILL OCCUR AT THE MARINA as in previous years. Lincoln Sailing Club

STATE PARK PERMITS: State park permits are needed for vehicles to enter Branched Oak State Recreation Area. Permits may be purchased at the park.

TIMES:

8-8:30 a.m. – Arrive and rig boat (Lincoln Sailing Club mast crane will be available for use)

9 a.m. – Registration, check-in and packet pick-up begins.

9:15 a.m. – Skippers meeting. Registration and packet pick-up will close 15 minutes after skippers meeting.

10:30 a.m. – First race.

Noon – Lunch provided.

6 p.m. – Racing done, dinner/social event at Lincoln Sailing Club grounds

COMPETITION FORMAT:

Portsmouth scoring with fleets: Catamaran Open, Dinghy Open, Cruiser Open, Sunfish Open. If four of the same boat model register, they will be given their own start. However, if three-or-fewer boats are left to start after fleet assignments, they may be combined with a fleet of similar boats. Crew can come and go, be substituted, etc., as long as the sailing director is notified of this at the skippers meeting. Crew changes are not allowed in order to change crew weight based on weather changes.

The event will consist of about five races. At least one race will be before lunch, with time to eat and tune boat before heading back out for the remainder of the races. No races starting after 5 p.m.

RULES: USSA and class rules will apply. Class membership is not required.

AWARDS: Custom Cornhusker State Games gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to each crew member of the top three finishing boats in each class.
