SITE: Nebraska Outdoor Educational Center, 4703 N 44th St, Lincoln, NE

EQUIPMENT: Any safe .22 caliber pistol. Firearms must fit in "the box". All firearms will be inspected for safety. .32 caliber, .38 caliber, 9 mm caliber, .40 caliber, 4s caliber pistols or revolvers used for Center Fire competition. Juniors and women may use .22 caliber during Center Fire event. No magnum loads. Eye and ear protection required. Open sights only. No scopes or red dot sights.

SANCTION: Competition is sanctioned by the National Rifle Association of America as a special tournament. NRA membership is not required.

RULES: Only safe gun handling is accepted. Chief Range Officer's decisions are final. Any unsafe behavior by shooters or spectators will not be tolerated. Safe, young shooters are welcome but must be supervised.

AWARDS: Custom Cornhusker State Games gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each event.

EVENT DESCRIPTIONS:

Expert: Experts are all registered shooters with a classification USA Shooting or NRA in any discipline.

Novice: Novices are all shooters without any classification. Novice shooters who have won a gold medal in the 2018 or 2019 Cornhusker State Games must shoot as an Expert.

Junior: Juniors are shooters 18 years or younger as of July 12, 2020.

Senior: Seniors are shooters 65 years or older as of July 12, 2020.

COMPETITION FORMAT

.22 Pistol: 30 Shots Total

2 strings-5 shots--150 seconds at 20 yards (B-6 target)

2 strings-5 shots--20 seconds at 20 yards (B-6 target)

2 strings-5 shots--10 seconds at 20 yards (B-6 target)

A maximum of 50 shooters per Standard Pistol division. Events will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Center Fire Pistol: 30 Shots for record

2 strings-5 shots--150 seconds at 20 yards (B-6 target)

2 strings-5 shots--20 seconds at 20 yards (B-6 target)

2 strings-5 shots--10 seconds at 20 yards (B-6 target)

A maximum of 50 shooters per Center Fire Pistol division. Events will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Revolver Pistol: 30 Shots for record

2 strings-5 shots--150 seconds at 20 yards (B-6 target)

2 strings-5 shots--20 seconds at 20 yards (B-6 target)

2 strings-5 shots--10 seconds at 20 yards (B-6 target)
