### Competition Rules and Guidelines

#### Tee Boxes and Rules by age group

Girls 9 to 10	#1 Tee Marker (1820 yds)	Stroke Limit 10	Front 9
Boys 9 to 10	#2 Tee Marker (2150 yds)	Stroke Limit 10	Front 9
Girls 11 to 12	#2 Tee Marker (2150 yds)	Stroke Limit 10	Front 9
Boys 11 to 12	Red Tee Marker (2600 yds)	Stroke Limit 10	Front 9
Girls 13 to 17	Red Tee Marker (5270 yds)	No Stroke Limit	18 Holes
Boys 13 to 14	White Tee Marker (6150 yds)	No Stroke Limit	18 Holes
Boys 15 to 17	Blue Tee Markers (6750 yds)	No Stroke Limit	18 Holes

#### Girls & Boys 9 to 12

Scoring monitors will be assigned to girls and boys groups 9 to 10 and 11 to 12, Scoring monitors are **NOT** rules officials. If you need a ruling please call or have your scoring monitor call the pro shop (402)564-1313 and an official will be sent to your hole. Players in this age group must walk each hole, rides from green to tee box are allowed and encouraged. Parents are allowed to caddie in this age group. Caddie **SHOULD** help carry clubs and help with club selection, make sure their player is in position and ready when it's his or her turn, tend the flag, rake sand traps, repair ball marks, replace divots and assist with keeping proper score. Caddies may carry or push the players equipment or they may rent a cart for \$10 from the Pro Shop. Players are **NOT** allowed in the cart during the play of the hole but may receive a ride from green to tee box. Caddies are **NOT** allowed to stand behind their player or physically move their player to assist with alignment, tee the ball up, give swing instruction or unduly delay play. Breach of these rules 1) warning 2) 2 shot penalty 3) disqualification.

#### Girls & Boys 13 to 17

Players must exchange scorecards. If in need of a ruling please call (402)564-1313 or flag down a roaming rule official. If a rules official is not available the player may play 2 balls, scoring both balls and a ruling will be made at the completion of play.

Caddies are NOT allowed in this age group. Players must walk the holes and carry or push his or her equipment.

#### All Players

OB is defined by white stakes or boundary fences (stroke and distance)

Penalty Area Hazards defined by red stakes and lines (Follow USGA rules for relief)

Drop Areas available on #4, #5, #13, #15 (Drop areas are optional relief)

### Course Conditions:

Due to reseeding and Spring weather conditions the course has some large areas of ground under repair. Due to the condition the following rules, in regards to ground under repair have been put in place to allow for a fair competition

### **The ball will be played as it lies unless in the following areas:**

Ground under repair is marked with white lines, players may drop within 1 club length no closer to the hole from their nearest point of relief.

On the following holes Large Areas are marked with white lines and signs. In these area players may **mark their ball and place the ball within 1 grip length of the balls original position no closer to the hole.**

Hole #3 Around the Green and Fairway Bunker (does not include sand trap)

Hole #4 Entire hole through the green

Hole #5 Green Surrounds (does not include sand trap)

Hole #6 Green Surrounds (does not include sand trap)

Hole #7 Green Surrounds (does not include sand trap)

Hole #11 Green Surrounds (does not include sand trap)

Hole #14 Entire hole through the green (does not include sand trap)

Hole #13 Entire area from 150 yards to the green

Hole #15 Green Surrounds (does not include sand trap)

Hole #16 Green Surrounds (does not include sand trap)

Hole #17 Green Surrounds
