Need To Know

- 1 Please plan to arrive early.** Traffic gets backed up significantly just prior to the start times.
- 2 Each runner will receive a timing chip and bib number at packet pick-up.**
- 3 Watch for signs.** There will be volunteers at key sections of the course. Watch for signs that mark turns, turnarounds, and mile markers.
- 4 Slower racers stay to the right of the path.** Runners pass on the left when possible.
- 5 There will be medics posted along the course.** If you see an injury along the way, report this to the next posted medic.

Chip Timing

Participants will have their timing chip on their race bib.

Directions/Parking

Enter from Line Drive off of Sun Valley Boulevard.
Charleston Street will close at 7:45 a.m.

Parking is available in the Southwest parking lot at Haymarket Park. Please enter Haymarket Park from Sun Valley Blvd and volunteers will direct you where to go. Access to parking in the Southwest lot will be available until 7:45 a.m.

If you arrive after 7:45 a.m, you will be directed to park in the Breslow Hockey Center parking lot. No cars will be able to leave the Southwest parking lot until all runners have completed the 5K at around 9 a.m.

Mile 1: From the start, head straight and turn left. Lap around the field complex 1 1/2 times.
Mile 2: Finish the partial lap around the complex and head towards the trail. Turn around when directed.
Mile 3: Run on the trail until you reach Line Drive Road, and then turn left. Finish the race inside Haymarket Park.
